Operation Rice Bowl

Moses had to overcome a great deal of disbelief before he became one of the great Biblical "friends of God." He knew his disabilities and his stumbling blocks quite well, and ultimately had to set his apprehensions aside. This week, try fasting from doubt. You might start by seeing what you're up against. Make a list of excuses and obstacles that keep you from hearing the cry of the poor and responding as you are called to. Prayerfully contemplate them as they emerge. Ask God to show you the alternative way, which turns reluctance into readiness. Very often it involves entering and relying on the very community you are asked to serve.
